State	Bill	Introduced	Description	Status
AZ	H2417	2/6/17	Amends the Arizona Electronic Transactions Act. Provides that signatures and records obtained through blockchain technology are electronic signatures and records.	<b>ENACTED</b> 3/29/17. Takes effect 90 days after adjournment.
AZ	S1078	1/12/17	Transfers authority to regulate electronic signatures used by government units from the secretary of state to the department of administration. In addition, the bill provides that state agencies shall accept electronic signatures.	<b>ENACTED</b> 3/27/17. Takes effect 90 days after adjournment.
CA	A380	2/9/17	Deletes the exemption from the UETA for conditional sale and lease contracts for motor vehicles. The bill would also require sellers and lessors to offer buyers and lessees the option of signing their respective contracts and agreements electronically.	Passed Assembly on 5/1/17.
CT	S360	1/19/17	Adopts the amendments to § 4A-108 that clarify the relationship of the federal Electronic Funds Transfer Act to UCC Article 4A.	<b>FAILED.</b> Died in committee when it failed to pass before deadline.
CT	S816	2/16/17	Adopts the amendments to § 4A-108 that clarify the relationship of the federal Electronic Funds Transfer Act to UCC Article 4A.	<b>ENACTED</b> 6/9/17. Takes effect 10/1/17.
ME	H377	2/8/17	Clarifies that the 6-year statute of limitations in the state's version of UCC Article 3A applies to all negotiable instruments notwithstanding an apparent 20-year statute of limitations provided for certain instruments by other law.	<b>ENACTED</b> 6/24/17. Takes effect 90 days after adjournment.

MD	H412	1/26/17	Repeal of UCC Article 6.	<b>FAILED.</b> Withdrawn from consideration on 2/20/17.
MD	S789	2/6/17	Repeal of UCC Article 6.	<b>FAILED.</b> Withdrawn from consideration on 2/20/17 after it failed to pass the Finance Committee.
MA	H44	3/16/17	Makes amendments to UCC Article 3.	Pending.
MA	H45	3/16/17	Adopts the Uniform Assignments of Rents Act.	Pending.
MO	H34	1/4/17	Enacts Revised Articles 1 and 7.	<b>ENACTED</b> on 5/8/17. Takes effect on 8/28/17.
MO	HCB1	3/27/17	Includes language identical to HB 34 to enact Revised Articles 1 and 7.	Passed House on 4/27/17.
NM	H182	1/20/17	Amends the state's version of UCC § 3-309. The amendment provides that the transferee of a note can enforce it if a direct or indirect transferor could have enforced it and provides for a lost-note affidavit.	Passed the Business and Industry Committee on 2/2/17.
NC	H263	3/7/17	Amends the state's version of UCC 3-311(a), inserting "...or failed to return the instrument within 90 days of receipt..." under (iii).	Assigned to Commerce and Job Development Committee.
OK	H1929	2/6/17	Adopts the amendments to § 4A-108 that clarify the relationship of the federal Electronic Funds Transfer Act to UCC Article 4A.	Assigned to Rules Committee.
VA	H1832	1/11/17	Applies 6-year statute of limitation to enforcement of negotiable and non-negotiable certificates of deposit.	<b>ENACTED</b> 3/20/17. Takes effect 7/1/17.
VA	S1217	1/10/17	Applies 6-year statute of limitation to enforcement of negotiable and non-negotiable certificates of deposit.	<b>ENACTED</b> on 2/20/17. Takes effect on 7/1/17.
